- **To wash**: to clean with some water.
- **B-** Language function: Describing repetitive actions (Present simple) and actions in progress (Present continuous).

Examples

- a) **Present simple**: I wear a jacket every day.
- b) **Present continuous:** Look! Seka is wearing a nice polo T-shirt today.
