5 The virus has killed over 5,100 people worldwide. Eight of them died in Nigeria. While his home country has been declared Ebola free, Ike is creating a voice messaging system to raise awareness about the killer disease in the three countries which are most affected: Liberia, Sierra Leone and Guinée.

10 “Over 70% of people in west Africa live in rural and semi-urban areas,” Ike, founder of the Halt-Ebola Mobile Service. “These groups usually do not have access to the internet but they have good mobile phone coverage. Therefore, we saw effectiveness in using voice, the oldest means of communication to reach people”. vision is to reach people who are afraid to call authorities and ask for help. The plan that citizens will receive a call from Halt-Ebola, but instead of getting advice from a  
15 foreign doctor, they will hear a recorded message from local celebrities.
